

1 June 2022 Seasonally Adjusted Labor Market Data Audio Text

3 Hello, my name is Mariana Vega, the director for Labor Market Information at the Texas Workforce  
4 Commission, and I'm going to highlight some of the information in the 2022 June labor market report.

5 The Texas seasonally adjusted unemployment rate settled at 4.1 percent in June after falling one-tenth  
6 of a percentage point over the month. The unemployment rate continues to improve, declining in 23 of  
7 the last 26 months.

8 Job growth accelerated from May as Total Nonfarm employment increased by 82,500 positions over the  
9 month which marked the eighth consecutive month of series-high job counts. In terms of COVID  
10 recovery, employment expanded by 464,900 jobs above the February 2020 level.

11 Education and Health Services led in June with a gain of 27,900 positions. Leisure and Hospitality  
12 followed with an increase of 12,700 jobs while Trade, Transportation, and Utilities trailed with an  
13 additional 11,400 positions.
